Thank you for the suggestions thus far! Keep them coming. As you all know, my wife and I attended the Elks National Convention in Austin the first week in July. Following are some of the highlights...
"Beacon of Hope" is this year's motto of the new

year's motto of the new Grand Exalted Ruler, Thomas Brazier. GER Brazier hails from Santa Cruz, CA Lodge #824.

Grand Lodge is putting as much energy into Community Service as it is into increasing membership, hoping that helping hands will make new members. What we are and what we do is what we need to let our communities know about.

Contributions to charities were \$348,508,863. of which 2.6 million was in scholarships. Applications for scholarships and for membership are now online.

The Resolutions and Results of the voting will be available in the Lounge in the near future. All but one resolution passed. The one that failed was the one to increase the fee to appeal to the highest tribunal from

\$500 to \$1,000 nonrefundable.

Two new Lodges have been formed. One has been granted a charter, the other one is pending. Four Lodges surrendered their charters. Seven Lodges have had their charters revoked either because the statutes were not fully followed or due to lack of membership. 14 Lodges merged into seven Lodges. Five Lodges have had name changes. That's eighteen Lodges gone.

Most lost Lodges became that way because they became clubs and hangouts for members. Lodge members forgot the purpose of a benevolent organization.

There will be many more Lodges going away without Community Projects, much needed public relations and new members. All three together help make a stronger Lodge.

Many members of Kinderhook Lodge are feeling tired. Please step up and give them a hand. Sunday Wednesday, and Friday meals need some



help. When we do an outside or district function, we need help. Watch the Board in the Lounge for dates and times for functions and sign up to help.

Sign up for Fair Parking. If everyone would work one shift, it would make it easier for the committee and the entire Lodge This is a major fundraiser for the Lodge, please help.


