FROM THE TRUSTEES OF THE LODGE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP NOTICE

The following By Law Amendments are hereby proposed and presented for consideration at the regular Lodge Meeting to be held on September 10th by the members of Kinderhook Elks Lodge #2530. These amendments shall be in effect for the next five year period (2012 thru 2017) as required by Grand Lodge.

Amendment 1. A one thousand dollar (\$1000) per annum raise for the Secretary and Treasurer of the Lodge. (Of the Secretary, Section 4, Paragraph 6 and Of the Treasurer, Section 5, Paragraph 1).

Amendment 2. A raise of twenty thousands dollars (\$20,000) in the amount of money that the Treasurer can keep on hand in the general fund before turning it over to the Trustees; (Of the Treasurer, Section 5, Paragraph1).

Amendment 3. A raise of twenty thousands dollars (\$20,000) in the amount of money that the Trustees shall allow the Treasurer to can keep on hand in the general fund before turning it over to the Trustees; (Of the Trustees, Section 7, Paragraph 2).

Amendment 4. ARTICLE VI - APPOINTIVE POSITIONS AND DUTIES -

ADD new sub-Section (VI-A), number and text....

INSERT/CREATE - ARTICLE- VI-A - Exemplification of Rituals: Sec. 1 - The officers of this Lodge are authorized to use alternative forms of the opening, closing and initiatory Rituals as approved by the Grand Lodge. (ARTICLE VI-A Appointive Positions and Duties, Section 1)

Amendment 5. An increase in the annual dues of \$10.00 per member. (Article X, Section 2, Paragraph 3).

These amendments will be voted upon for inclusion in the revised By-Laws of Kinderhook Lodge #2530 at the regular Lodge meeting to be held on September 10, 2012.
